### Soaring takes wing

Although she is making her debut on the water, SOARING, the new super yacht built by the solid Abeking & Rasmussen shipyard in Lemwerder, Germany, already shows all her charisma through a unique name inspired by the majestic flight of an eagle spreading its wings with a proud and confident gaze.

Tested between February and March of this year by conducting all the most appropriate sea trials with the aim of testing its performance at sea, and built according to Lloyd's specifications, in April SOARING will take the route to her new owner who entrusted the fully-tailored project to FOCUS Yacht Design in Bremen, the designer that covered all the details with an integrated, modern and timeless vision.

"We are very excited to see how great our concepts for interior and exterior design are coming into being. The shipyard works like clockwork and the opportunity to work on both design spheres allows an integrated and holistic approach. As a result, the yacht turned out modern and timeless at the same time" said Thomas Mühe, Managing Director of FOCUS Yacht Design.

The sophisticated and elegant interiors match with the exteriors along the three

decks, featuring a clever use of large and original integrated windows that contribute to shaping a creative and functional design together with the glass doors. To this end, a key role was played by innovative research endeavours and state-of-the-art technology used in the glass industry, making it possible to create increasingly complex shapes.

She comfortably accommodates up to twelve guests distributed among the six passenger rooms, including the master suite located on the private aft upper deck and the other guest rooms on the main deck.

An extremely reserved, roomy and well-equipped sundeck is available, with large sunbathing and relaxation areas that are complemented by a jacuzzi facility. Alfresco dining with innovative glass screen wind deflector is ideal for enjoying every moment of the day, while an elegant wellness centre connects to the spacious beach club aft of the yacht, leading to the large bathing platform, where guests can enjoy water games while relying on the support of a crew of up to 17 members. The tenders are stored at the bow, where they can be taken out by opening the large hatches, while service balconies opening flush with the water are located in the





middle section of the yacht.

The outstanding new 68-metre superyacht showcases a solid and robust trait, has gained a more functional design thanks to its aluminium superstructure and hull in steel, and features a boundless reach with its gross tonnage of over 1,500 tonnes. The yacht is suitably sized to venture out to the most beautiful destinations world-wide, with a maximum speed of 16 knots or a cruising speed of 14 knots. However, we anticipate that she will be available for charter in the Mediterranean area with Naples, Sicily, Riviera, Corsica and Sardinia at the top of the list during the hot weeks of this coming summer characterised by a new season of rediscovered fun. SOARING joins the solid and original fleet of Abeking & Rasmussen as they continue to perform well in the creation of successful superyachts such as Cloudbreak, Aviva, Elandess and Excellence, which have all set their indelible DNA mark in yachting.
