

Cooperation between ABEKING & RASMUSSEN and FASSMER

On December 14, the keel was laid for the first joint project of ABEKING & RASMUSSEN and FASSMER, a 105 m hydrographic vessel.

Following the recent successful delivery of two minehunting vessels to the Indonesian Navy, A&R was also commissioned to build the new hydrographic vessel in December last year. As the ship concept is based on a proven design by FASSMER, the project was handled jointly from the beginning. While A&R, as general contractor, is responsible for the customer's requirements in terms of delivery, local value creation and transfer of technology, FASSMER is responsible for the design and construction of the vessel. The new build will carry out various research activities in the world's largest archipelago state. It is also suitable for strengthening SAR capabilities in Indonesian and international waters.

The customer is the Indonesian Institute of Hydrography "Bantu Hidro-Oseanografi" (BHO). The ship is operated by the Indonesian Navy. Delivery is scheduled for December 2025.
